It's a way that retired nurses can take action to:

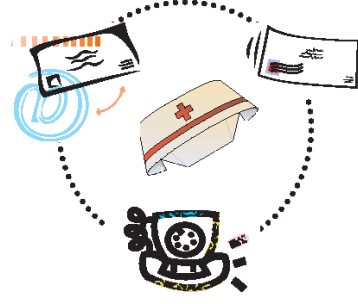
- ✓ protect pensions and benefits

In the latest Provincial Collective Agreement, BCNU negotiated

1% of the salary to be set aside

for the purpose of protecting retiree

benefits beginning April 1, 2007. The

Union is discussing how this 1% of salary

will be used. It may be used to top up

your extended health, dental and/or MSP

premiums or set aside to enhance inflation

protection in the future. No decisions have

yet been made and no agreement has been

made with either the Municipal or Public

Service pension plans. If you retired as

a registered nurse, registered psychiatric

nurse or licensed graduate nurse and

were a member of one of the unions in the

Nurses' Bargaining Association, you may be

eligible to benefit from this funding.
