The Strategic Nursing Staffing Committee (SNSC) has met to discuss both long-term and short–term staffing strategies for the Interior Health Authority (IHA).

Some of the key discussion points from the last meeting included:

- An IHA Working Group has been established to review specialty nursing opportunities and develop strategies to fill vacancies.
- The Working Group is soliciting feedback from nurses including a recent survey to ER staff on a Travel Nurse Program. The results and outcome will be reported out through SNSC.
- IHA has approved twenty-eight (28) additional seats for specialty education with the goal of completing education by the end of March 2020.
