It has been five months since our last SNSC Joint Employer and Union discussion day and nine months since the 2019 - 2022 Nurses' Bargaining Association (NBA) Provincial Collective Agreement was ratified. It is important that each SNSC continue its work to address nurse workforce planning and issues from a strategic perspective. Our ability to work together and focus on the complex contributing factors is essential.

Given the important work underway on the direct patient care assessment staffing process and working short premium that will be in effect April 1, 2020, we will focus our provincial SNSC forums to better understand the current state and focus on key imperatives to ensure overall success. On November 27, 2019, we will focus on the development and implementation of successful patient care assessment staffing processes in order to enable success.
