Following the horrific tragedy that occurred at the Lapu Lapu Day festival in Vancouver on April 26, and as a union proud to represent thousands of Filipino members, BCNU extends our deepest condolences to the victims. BCNU President Adriane Gear has shared a special bulletin to all members, acknowledging the heartache and sharing sympathy with the many who were injured as they and their families struggle to recover from this life-altering experience.
