## Retired Nurses Invited to Participate in COVID-19 Immunization Campaign

Interior Health (IH) has immediate openings for retired nurses to support COVID-19 immunization programs. The current campaign began Sept. 19 and lasts six weeks. IH has casual positions across all of the IH region, and also needs help in communities such as Vernon and Penticton. IH is offering to cover car travel and accommodation expenses. Requirements for this campaign include proof of your vaccination status and graduation from an approved school of nursing. An emergency license to practice is NOT required. Applicants will need to complete immunization competency course modules. ## Ageism Consultation

You are invited to share your thoughts on how ageism affects older Canadians. The Federal, Provincial and Territorial Ministers Responsible for Seniors are launching a public consultation to gain a better understanding of how older adults experience ageism, and possible solutions for addressing it. You can take part in the consultation by sharing your personal experiences and completing a questionnaire here by Sept. 30, 2022. The consultation will be followed by community-led group discussions this fall. Feedback will be summarized in a report that will inform development of proposed approaches, initiatives and strategies to address ageism in Canada.
